

## Workshops at Denmark Arts



Denmark Arts hosts artists to run workshops within our venue with a shared box office arrangement at the following rates:

- Non-Members - 15% of all ticket sales
- Members - 10% of all ticket sales

*Plus a \$55 fee to use the workshop space*

### **Our Service:**

Under these arrangements we provide:

- Assistance with poster design, printing and distribution
- Website, social media and E-news promotion
- Promotion on Denmark FM and in our regular Denmark Bulletin column
- Use of venue to run workshop
- Ticketing through our website
- Tea/coffee and use of small kitchen for lunch breaks

What we require from you:

- Minimum of six weeks advance notice of workshop
- Promo copy, bio, relevant links, logos, artwork and/or high-resolution image, including a square image for website and Instagram
- To do a building induction prior to the workshop
- To be the host and facilitator of the workshop
- To return the venue to the same state you found it in

### **Notes:**

- Whilst Denmark Arts artists need to be actively involved in promoting their event
- There must be two ticket prices available - one for members and one for non-members
- Ticket prices should cover all your material costs

### **Two Space options to choose from:**

1. Denmark Arts Makers Space: Best for visual art and craft workshops
  - This space can accommodate max 10x participants to each workshop
  - Has concrete floors, so can accommodate messy mediums
  - The space has a small sink area for washing up and multiple power points
  - Good natural lighting
  - Trestle tables and chairs
2. Denmark Arts Lounge: Best for contained movement, mediation, music or non-mess craft workshops
  - This space can accommodate max 20x participants to each workshop depending on activity
  - Has carpeted floors, so cannot accommodate any messy mediums
  - Café style tables, couches, trestle tables and chairs available for workshops
  - Kitchen attached to space

### **Artist Accommodation:**

Denmark Arts has a residency studio space which includes a sleeping area with a queen size bed, desk, and seating area that looks out on to a small creek and bush reserve. Plus, its own ensuite and kitchenette equipped with basic cooking facilities. To stay in the accommodation for 3 nights we charge a \$150 service fee to artists running a workshop through that time.
