

## Gigs and Small Concert Events



For live music gigs, small concerts and intimate performances we offer a shared box office arrangement at the following rates:

- Non-Members - 30% of ticket sales
- Members - 25% of ticket sales

### ***Our Service***

Under these arrangements we provide:

- Poster design, printing and distribution
- Website, social media and E-news promotion
- Promotion on Denmark FM and in our regular Denmark Bulletin column
- Use of venue, pa and lighting for four hours
- Ticketing through our website and on the door
- Front of House volunteer and an RSA trained staff member for four hours
- Sound and lighting technician for four hours
- Firewood for outside fire pits
- Small bar open half an hour prior to set starting and running for the duration of the set
- Tea/coffee and use of small kitchen

What we require from you:

- Minimum of six weeks advance notice of event
- Promo copy, bio, relevant links, logos, artwork and/or high-resolution image, including a square image for website and Instagram

*Notes:*

- For events to be worthwhile for everyone involved we need to attract a minimum of 40 attendees, therefore artists need to be actively involved in promoting their event
- For events likely to attract a smaller audience, it is recommended that ticket prices are a minimum of \$20
- There must be two ticket prices available - one for members and one for non-members
- Venue capacity is:
  - Seated - 60
  - Standing / with use of outside - 100
- For events likely to attract a full capacity dancing crowd, we will obtain a liquor license for the event providing the event is programmed with adequate advance notice
- For events attracting less than 75 people we will run a bar under the small function exemption for four hours which must be closed by 10pm
- For events attracting between 75 and 100 people we can run a bar under the small function exemption for two hours only. If you are presenting an act which is likely to attract a full capacity dancing crowd, ideally we need 6 weeks advance notice so that we can obtain an occasional liquor license for the event.
