

# DENMARK ARTS MARKETS

## Stall Criteria 2019/2020

The Denmark Arts Markets, established in 1981, attracts between 18,000-20,000 visitors across the season and has built its reputation on the philosophy of providing an outlet for high quality artisan, arts, crafts and produce. Set in shady Berridge Park by the picturesque Denmark River, the markets have a lively village atmosphere featuring all day live performance on possibly WA's largest market stage showcasing emerging and established, local and national talent.

This season we are delighted to include the Australia Day long weekend as one of our market dates!

### All applications must meet the following criteria:

- Goods should be hand-made or produced by the stallholder.
- Goods and services to be unique and of a good to high quality.
- High stallholder involvement in production.
- No single use plastic is to be used for packaging, serving or presentation of products.
- The principle stallholder must be a current member of The Denmark Arts Council. If not a current member, at time of application, the fee will be included on your invoice.

We do allow a limited number of stalls offering:

- Community information/education/fundraising
- Natural therapy and wellbeing practitioners
- Quality second-hand clothing

### Exclusions

- Retail chains or franchises
- Mass produced or imported goods
- Alcoholic beverages (for consumption on site)
- Political parties or Religious groups

### Cost to trade:

Applications to be received 6 weeks prior to market date. Applications received after this date will incur a 10% late application fee.

14 Dec 2019 market: 3x3m stall - \$75 | ½ stall 1.5x3m - \$45 (apply by 2<sup>nd</sup> Nov)

4 Jan 2020 market: 3x3m stall - \$90 | ½ stall 1.5x3m - \$55 (apply by 23<sup>rd</sup>)

25 Jan 2020 market: 3x3m stall - \$90 | ½ stall 1.5x3m - \$55 (apply by 14<sup>th</sup> Dec)

11 Apr 2020 (Easter Sat) market only: 3m<sup>2</sup> stall \$140 | ½ stall 1.5x3m - \$80 (apply by 29<sup>th</sup> Feb)

If booking Easter market with one or more other markets: 3m<sup>2</sup> stall \$120 | ½ stall 1.5x3m - \$70 (apply by 29<sup>th</sup> Feb)

Limited number of larger food stalls available (eg 4.5m x 3m). Please enquire.

Power: \$20 per connection.

**Season Discount:** 10% on stall fees; accepted when booking all 4 market dates with payment of invoice in full paid by 22<sup>nd</sup> Nov (discount applies to stall fee only and does not include cost of membership or power connection)

ACNC registered not-for-profit or charities - 50% discount on stall fees.
